
#### **Olympics**

#### **COVID 19 - Positive cases**

All positive cases confirmed at a testing clinic (students and staff) are asked to notify the school of the absence and contact the Education Reporting Line at <a href="mailto:1-833-308-0286">1-833-308-0286</a> or <a href="mailto:psblearning@edu.pe.ca">psblearning@edu.pe.ca</a> for further direction.

Reducing the spread of COVID-19 in our schools relies on all of us to do our part.

We have public health measures in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission in our schools. For more information, visit COVID-19 and Back to School.

- If your child tested positive (on a lab-confirmed PCR or rapid molecular test at a testing clinic) on or after December 15th, 2021 AND they have completed their self-isolation period AND are not experiencing symptoms – there is no need to perform a rapid antigen test prior to school attendance. At this time, they will be considered exempt from the rapid antigen test screening program for school (for a period of 90 days from their positive result).
  - Should symptoms develop stay home and do not attend school until symptoms are resolved. Contact your child's school, or the Education COVID-19 Response Team after-hours and weekends at 1-833-308-0286 to make them aware of your situation.
